Learning Achievements

Reception: This week we have been reading 'The Loud' book and talking about what sounds we like. In Maths we have been looking at, and solving, adding problems and creating 3D shape models. We have completed our Commando Joe's mission with Nursery.

Class 1: this week we have been looking at features of recipes and writing our own. In Maths we have been exploring 3D shape patterns and describing 3D shapes using faces, edges and vertices.

Also this week we have been working on our dance for the dance festival. Our song is 'I can see the Light' from Tangled. Please can they bring in a plain coloured t-shirt (red, orange or yellow), black shorts and sandshoes.

Class 2: this week the older children have been participating in their Bikeability. The weather certainly tested their bike skills and endurance - or that may have been just Mrs Barker!
