Learning Achievements

Reception: have been counting backwards and forwards and writing number sentences. In English, they have been continuing their work on fairy stories and thinking of alternative endings for their favourite stories.

Class 1: in Maths, Year 1 have been ordering numbers and Year 2 have been concentrating on multiplication and division. In English they have been planning and retelling the story of 'The Tunnel'. As part of their topic work they have been building and constructing towers with different materials.

Class 2: have been finding the area and perimeter of different shapes, they have also been converting metres to centimetres and vice versa. In English they have been reading Robert Falcon Scott's diary focusing on his last 3 entries. The children then wrote their own diary entry as if they were Scott enduring the harsh extreme weather that is notorious in the Antarctica. In Science they have been looking at simple and complex food chains of animals which live in the Polar regions.
