

History in Year 3

- I can use simple artefacts, photographs and books to answer questions about the past.
- I can ask and answer questions about an archaeological site (Skara Brae).
- I can talk about events, places and people beyond living memory (Explosion of Pompeii, Viking invasion).
- I can use historical terms such as 'modern, recent, long ago and longer' to describe the passage of time.
- I can place objects, people and events from beyond living memory in order of time (Early humans, pre-historic inventions, invasions).
- I can describe key features of events and people from the past.
- I compare events from the past and the present and begin to explain how these effected people at the time (Invention of farming, eruption at Pompeii).
- I can describe changes of lifestyle between past and present.
- I can talk about events from the life of a well-known historical person. I can begin to give reasons for their actions (Mary Anning, King Athelstan).

History in Year 4

As above and...

- I can use a range of information to ask and answer questions from the past (primary and secondary sources).
- I can use pictures and written sources to build a picture about the past.
- I can describe how the past has been divided into periods of time.
- I can use the terms BC and AD to describe dates of invasions and occupation.
- I can describe key features of historical events beyond living memory.
- I can identify themes and features from historical events.
- I can explain and give reasons for events in the past and present.
- I can use a range of sources to find out about a significant historical person.
- I can talk about and give reasons for actions and events.



Key studies within History in Lower Key Stage 2

Pre- Roman Britain

- I can talk about how Britain changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Roman Britain

- I know what the Roman Empire is and I can list some of the changes that it brought to Britain.

Anglo-Saxons and Scots

- I know that the Anglo Saxons and the Scots settled in Britain, and I can give the locations of some of these settlements.

Anglo Saxons and Vikings

- I can discuss the arrival of the Vikings in Britain and how and why they invaded.

Ancient Civilisations

- I can list the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians.
