Learning Achievements

Reception/Class 1: This week we have been creating our own storyboards and writing about how things have changed over the years. In Maths we have been comparing numbers and adding equal groups and using repeated addition.

They created their own non-chronological report on the heart in English which the children will read to the class 1 children in school.
