Learning Achievements

Reception: This week Reception have been on a walk around the village and discussed their favourite part of the walk. We have also been busy making a bike wash so we could wash all our bikes. In Maths, we have been playing lots of games to help us recognise numbers in different ways.

Class 1: This week we have been created our own fact book about The Queen and started creating freeze frames from the story 'Katie in London'.

In Maths, Year 1 have been working on subtraction and Year 2 have been working on adding tens and adding 1 digit to a two digit number.

Class 2: This week the children have been learning about medicines from the past. They have asked questions to find out about surgery from the past and how it has changed. The children then created expanded noun phrases to improve their descriptions in English. As part of our Maths lessons, the children have learned to use formal written methods to add and subtract. Our R.E lessons have given us the chance to explore the Holy Trinity. The children have worked very hard this week.

Class 3: In class 3 this week the children chose their favourite impressionist painting and wrote a short narrative about it. Their description had to include figurative language and it needed to paint a picture on the reader's mind. In Maths the children have been interpreting line graphs and dividing 4 digit numbers by 2 digit numbers using the long division method. In geography the children were researching famous art galleries in the world and then plotting their location on a map of the world. They also wrote about each gallery.
