The children will be covering the following concepts in numeracy this term:

Number and place value, addition and subtraction, measures and data including length, weight and bar charts, fractions, money, measures and shape including time, position and direction, multiplication and division.

Literacy

Will be based on our topic this term, the children will be covering the following genres:

- Playscripts-Romulus and Remus
- Instructions-how to play a Roman board game
- diary writing
- creative writing-pop up books to read to the younger children in school.

French

Music

We will be learning new songs all to do with food. The children will also be choosing their own accompanying instruments to play whilst singing.
