



Self-isolation and testing requirements in schools from 17/01/22




Ending self-isolation early using LFD tests (Updated from 17th January 2022 onwards)

It is now possible to end self-isolation after 5 full days if you have 2 negative LFD tests taken on consecutive days. The first LFD test should not be taken before the fifth day after your symptoms started (or the day your test was taken if you did not have symptoms). The self-isolation period remains 10 full days for those without negative results from 2 LFD tests taken a day apart.
