Learning Achievements

Reception/Class 1: this week we have created a story map of the Gruffalo and we used our maps to rewrite the story. We have looked at bar models and fact families in Maths. The children are excited that their new mud kitchen has arrived and are looking forward to using it.

Class 2: this week the children have been trying to impress Emperor Claudius by testing their strength, agility and tactics in different physical challenges so that the Emperor will select them for his army! In Maths the children have been using the column addition and subtraction method to work out different place value and word problems. Comparing Italy and Britain in topic has given the children the opportunity to learn a little more about the country where the Romans came from. In Science the children are still discussing the important business of going to the toilet in Roman times!
