Learning Achievements

Reception: This week we have been investigated objects that are lighter or heavier than Sleeping Beauty's poisoned apple and creating different sized gingerbread men. We have also been busy being elves creating our own shoe creations.

Class 1: This week we have started to create our own newspaper article about Rapunzel and thinking about which construction material would be best to create a tower for Rapunzel. In Maths, we have been looking at creating tally charts and place value.

Class 2: This week in Maths the children have been subtracting fractions, using scale factors and dividing both 2 and 3digit numbers. In English the children have been looking at board game instructions to help them write their own instructions for a new board game that they have created. The instructions needed to be clear and precise, incorporating imperative verbs, time adverbials and colons. In R.E Elias is team teaching with me to help the children in class learn all about Judaism.
