


Reception/Class 1: Alfie for using resources to match equal groups in Maths.

Reception/Class 1: This week we have been getting ready for our Teddy Bear's picnic and experimenting with mixing colours to create our friendship tree. We have also been looking at representing numbers in different ways and how to make equal groups.

Class 2: this week the children have been learning all about the effect smoking has on your health. The children have been creating slogans to use in their anti-smoking adverts which they created using a program called Comic Life. In Maths the children have been identifying and converting mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa, while the lower KS2 children have been multiplying by 10. The children experimented with Brusho paints in art creating abstract paintings using different shades of red.
