

The P.E. and Sports Premium spending report 2016/17

This year our school received £8155.00 in funding from the Sports Partnership.

We spent a total of £8227.30 on sporting equipment and facilities between April 2016 and March 2017. This included £4368.30 on resources, £1137.00 on coaches for travel to sporting events and the remaining £2722.00 was used to part fund residential sports trip to Dukeshouse Wood.

The resources included items such as football coaching, dance workshops and a dance festival, gymnastics and multi skills coaching, netball posts, skipping ropes, footballs, netballs, pumps, kwik cricket sets, 5 a side football nets, team bibs, storage and PE uniform for staff. Hiring qualified sports coaches to work alongside teachers when teaching PE.

- Providing places for pupils for after school sport clubs.
- Increasing participation in school sport.
- Monitoring and lesson observations.
- Providing opportunities for children to compete (i.e. in tournaments and fixtures between the local cluster primary special schools).
- Continued professional development (CPD) and curriculum delivery support.
- Attendance of local cluster updates.
- The purchase of sporting equipment and resources.
- Quality lunchtime activities to allow children to participate in games and help run the mini sessions by becoming a lunchtime PE leader.

The replenishment of resources is crucial to the ongoing development of sport within our school; the children need lightweight, safe, working equipment to assist their progression and development from EYFS through to Year 6.

As a school we are passionate about encouraging the children to take part in as many sporting opportunities given to them as possible as we think this is fundamental to the advancement of both their social skills and sporting ability. To make this possible for all students, regardless of their parents' financial

position, we are committed to providing transport to and from as many events as we are able to.

After a successful first year, we made the decision to fund Carlisle united football training for a second time.
