

Learning Achievements

Reception: This week we have been creating number 5 stamps in different ways and looking at one more and one less. We have had lots of fun dressing up and practising our songs for the Christingle service and creating our own angels.

Class 1: This week in Maths, Year 2 have been exploring money and adding notes and coins whilst Year 1 has been looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We have also had a class debate about whether it is best to live in the city or the country. We have also been practising our songs for the Christingle service and made our own angels.

Class 2: This week the children have been rewriting the final scene of Romeo and Juliet; the boys and girls were able to give the play a happier ending than the original. We have been focusing on our times tables in Maths and looking at patterns within multiples of 2 and 5. Christmas has also slowly crept into class 2 this week and we have made some excellent Christmas cards and angels.

Class 3: In class 3 this week the children have been creating angels to go to Church and also to hang in the window at home.
