Learning Achievements



Reception: Reception children are learning about seaside poetry and talking about words to describe shells.

Class 1: This week we have been learning about Grace Darling and why she became famous. In maths Yr1 have been learning how to partition 10s and ones with numbers up to 100. Yr 2 has been learning x2, x5 and x10 tables with great success.

Class 2: This week we have continued our exploration of the sea and have created observational drawings of sea animals. The children were fantastic at sketching a creature of their choice and using shading techniques. In our English lessons we have begun to explore the life of Jaques Cousteau, a famous inventor and explorer. We have discussed how we could organise all of our research by grouping it into paragraphs. Our maths lessons have focused on money and decimals. During our RE sessions we have been comparing different religious festivals.

Class 3: This week in class 3 the children have been writing biographies on social reformers and change-makers of the Victorian era. The children selected who they wanted to write about and then researched their significant person to find facts and information. Today they wrote their first draft of their biography.

In maths the children have been calculating missing angles and finding interior angles of polygons.

This afternoon the children tried their hand at cross stitch as they are going to embroider their names just like in Victorian times!

GREENHEAD C.E.PRIMARY SCHOOL KEY STAGE 2 SWIMMING LESSONS AUTUMN TERM 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to offer a weekly swimming lesson to our Key Stage 2 children (Years 3,4,5 & 6) every Tuesday at the Wentworth Swimming Pool, Hexham during the Autumn Term, beginning on $\underline{\text{Tuesday 14}}^{\text{th}}$ September 2021. In all, there will be 13 lessons during the term.

As with previous years, it will only be possible for us to offer swimming lessons if parents are willing to make a voluntary contribution of £5.35 (£2.40 per lesson + £2.95 transport cost). It would greatly reduce administration time and costs if parents could pay for the lessons on a half-termly basis using the School Gateway App (please let the school office know if you need help with registering for this).

ii) Autumn 2^{nd} Half Term - Swimming payment requested by Friday 15^{th} October $2021 = £37.45$
