£6500	We bought into the Tynedale Sports Partnership who provided coaches to work alongside our class teachers on a weekly basis to develop skills in teaching across the range of sports within the PE curriculum.	The PE co-ordinator observed the sports coach teach each term to ensure consistent high standards and expertise were upheld in teaching and developing skills across the range of sports in the curriculum. The PE co-ordinator also worked alongside the sports coach in planning high quality sessions. This ensures enhanced quality of teaching and learning. Each term the staff observe Sports Coach and Team teach to up skill PE knowledge and lesson delivery. Our teachers all now feel much more confident and competent across the PE curriculum. So far they have focused in particular on invasion games, gymnastics, dance, orienteering and exploring links across the curriculum with PE. Pupil voice sessions confirm a vast majority of children said they felt their PE skills had improved as a result of the sessions.

In conjunction with the expert instruction from our sports specialists, the teachers are much better equipped to teach gymnastics and tennis. We allow the equipment to be explored and used at break times. This has provided learners with an opportunity to take part in healthy, competitive sport, which has raised enthusiasm in various sports.
£250	Swimming for Pupil Premium	After conversing with parents it was decided that our Pupil Premium pupils have access swimming lessons. The children made good progress towards their swimming goals and are now in line with their peers.

By taking part in this competition the children reached new levels of fitness and made progress towards age related expectations in PE.
