Learning Achievements

Reception: In maths we have been looking at and making number from 13-20. We have been creating mini beasts and describing them, as well as making bug hotels outside in the lovely sunshine.

Class 1: In maths this week the children have been working very hard on part-whole models up to 20. The children have been recalling addition and subtraction facts to 20 and using related facts up to 100.

The children have enjoyed making mini beast habitats in the nature garden. We have also enjoyed learning some interesting facts about ants.

Class 2: Class 2 were poets this week! We have been exploring different poetic features and using these to describe volcanoes. Miss Callaghan was very impressed with everybody's use of similes and rhyming couplets and she cannot wait to read everyone's own poems.

In our maths lessons we have been learning formal methods to divide and we have started to look at using bar models to solve scaling problems. As part of our Tremors topic, we have explored the inside of a volcano and found the different features.

We have also enjoyed our Commando Joes work this week and look forward to tackling another problem next week.

Class 3: This week in class 3 the children have been creating their very own riddles to perform at King Henry's banquet for all the Royal guests! Their riddles were describing Tudor objects and certainly made the children think when they were listening to each other when they performed their riddle to the class.

In maths the children have been finding fractions of amounts and finding the area of triangles and parallelograms. In art we have been painting miniature portraits using very fine brushes and a magnifying glass!

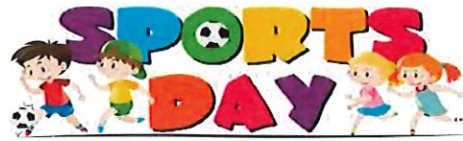
