## Learning Achievements

Reception - This week Reception have been looking at the story Jack and the Beanstalk and talking about their favourite parts as well as showing a good understanding of the story. In Maths they have been comparing mass and exploring the balance scales.

Class 1 - In KS1 we have been looking at descriptive writing about characters from Goldilocks and creating expanded noun phrases using our list of adjectives we created as a class. In Maths Year 1 have been looking at number bonds to 10 and Year 2 have been looking at fact families.
Class 2 - This week may have ended differently to how it began, but Class 2 have worked as hard as ever. In English, we began to write our Stonehenge information texts, using fronted adverbials to make our sentences more interesting. In maths, the children have been learning about negative numbers. The children have been thinking the promises we make in our lives as part of our RE lessons. Home learning has also started this week and the children have already produced some fantastic work.

Class 3 - In class 3 this week the Year 6 children have been using column addition and subtraction to solve different problems and the Year 5 children have been rounding numbers. The children have continued their story writing; with Roman coins being the stimulus. Back in the Beautiful House the mummies were coated in resin and then wrapped in strips of linen. Amulets were placed between the layers of linen to make their journey into the Afterlife complete.
