Learning Achievements

Reception/Class 1: This week we have been busy making mini robots and we found a rocket that had crashed in the nature garden. We have been trying to find out what had happened to the rocket! In Maths we have been exploring 2D Shapes.

Class 2: the children have been reading a poem titled 'The Eagle' by Tennyson. They have been looking at the different features of his poem and the vocabulary he used. Choosing their own bird of prey, the children then created their own Haiku poem following the 5-7-5 syllables formation. In Maths the children have been multiplying, dividing and rounding. We had a very special visitor in class on Thursday in the form of Roman soldier, Maximus. The children handled his sword, wore his helmet and carried his shield and javelin. Once outside the children used their shields to protect them from a Celtic attack. The children created their very own Remembrance poppies by painting pebbles, which were left at the war memorial this morning.
