# **Learning Achievements**

**Reception:** have been looking at words to describe different sounds and, in Maths, have been describing and creating patterns. They have also made ice cream with KS1 and listened to what sounds they were making.

**Class 1:** have been making ice cream and observing how the ingredients changed shape. They have started to create their own animation story and, in Maths, have been comparing length and height.

**Class 2:** have travelled back in time to the 1800's, where they are living and working in Hexham. The children have studied pages from the marriage register, a 1841 census and we have learnt about jobs and houses available back then. With this information the children have written their autobiography which included the impact the new railway in 1835 had on their lives. In Maths the children have been counting in fractions and learning about tenths and hundredths. Light source or reflective was the question posed in science. The children sorted different objects into the correct group and now have a better understanding of retro-reflective material.
