




Reception/Class 1: Jack for working confidently on his two times table.

Learning Achievements

Reception/Class 1: this week we have been preparing an invitation for a teddy bear's picnic for the parents to come to on Friday, 18th January at 2pm (invitation to follow). In Maths, Year 2 have been looking at unequal and equal groups and Year 1 and Reception have been looking at representing numbers using resources.

Class 2: the children have been learning all about blood and the important role it has. They created a class mind map full of blood facts. They then designed and created a shape poem either about the functions of the heart or the movement of blood through the body. In Science, the children labelled the different parts of the heart and learnt a little bit about the functions of this big muscle. Simplifying fractions by dividing and factor bugs have been keeping the children occupied in Maths this week. They have also been learning all about blood donors and the importance of giving blood.
