Learning Achievements

Reception: have been rewriting the story of 'The Gruffalo' with new characters and settings. In Maths they have looked at more and fewer and have been learning the days of the week and months of the year. They have built rafts in the Nature Garden and sailed them in the river. They have been sharing their thought on special places and visited the Church.

Class 1: Year 1s have been learning about place value using Maths resources including dienes and Numicon and Year2s have been working with 3D shapes. In Science they have been deciding which habitat to create in the Nature Garden. They have used the iPads to take the photos to create a big map of the Nature Garden to use with the Beebot.
