Dear Parents

We hope you have all had an enjoyable summer and it is lovely to see all the children back in school. We would like to give a special mention to our new starters in Reception for settling in so well.

Uniform

We would like to remind you that correct school uniform should be worn, including suitable school shoes. On Mondays children should wear school jumpers, tracksuit bottoms and trainers.

All uniform and water bottles must be clearly labelled.

Please can children bring in their bookbags, home/school books and reading diaries (if they have them) on a daily basis except for Mondays.

Fruit & Milk

Fresh fruit is provided daily for children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 and all children are allowed to bring extra fruit in for a snack if they wish. A reminder that milk is available daily at playtime - £11.50 for the term or free to those children who receive Free School Meals and those children aged under 5 for the whole term.

We would encourage all parents who are entitled to Free School Meals to apply for them; your child is entitled to pupil premium funding and also free milk and subsidised educational activities.

Nut Allergy

Please can we remind you that we have a child in school with a severe nut allergy so no nuts are allowed in school in any form, eg peanut butter, peanut topped cereal bars, packets of nuts, etc.
