#### **Learning Achievements**

Reception: this week we have been learning about Shrove Tuesday and Ash Wednesday and even made pancakes. We have been on a sound walk and recording different sounds we could hear throughout the walk. In Maths, we have been learning how to use a part whole model.

Class 1: this week we have been making a big mess during our messy play session; we have been using adjectives to describe the different substances we were playing with and we have started to read George's Marvellous Medicine. In Maths, we have started to look at 2D and 3D shapes.

Class 2: this week the children have been learning all about emails and blogs. The children sent Mrs Hutchinson several emails to try to persuade her to let them create a class blog.
