- I can develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour (the colour wheel), pattern, texture, line, shape, form and shape and space.
- I can learn about the work of a range of artists (Picasso, Van Gogh and Goldsworthy), craft makers (Gormley) and designers (Kinnear and Calvert).
- I can describe the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines and make links to my own work.
- I can evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design.
- I can use a range of materials creatively to design and make products.
- I can use natural materials to consider pattern and texture (e.g. stones, leaves, feathers, sticks, grasses, shells).
- I can use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share my ideas, experiences and imagination.
- I can produce creative work, exploring my ideas and recording my experiences.
- I can explain how a piece of art makes me feel link to emotions I feel and give reasons for this.
