Learning Achievements

Reception: have been learning about good and bad characters within fairy tales and counting up to 20. They have also been to the Sill to listen to stories.

Class 1: have enjoyed their first swimming lesson and have been learning about different parts of a castle and looking at direct speech. In Maths Year 1 have been looking at counting forwards and backwards up to 100 and Year 2 have been using arrays to help them with their multiplication.

Class 2: to engage the children at the start of their Frozen Kingdom topic the children observed mini icebergs! Using their senses the children created a list of adjectives to describe the icebergs. We have been researching Arctic animals in science and locating both the Arctic and Antarctic in atlases and on the globe. The children have been reading historical documents in English recalling the tragic disaster of RMS Titanic. What a busy time and it's only the first week back!
