

### Numeracy

The children will be covering the following areas in maths this term:

- Fractions
- Addition and subtraction
- Time, shape and data
- Money
- Measurements

### Literacy

Literacy will continue to be based on our topic this term, the children will be covering the following written tasks using our text, Beowulf:

Conversations, recounts, invitations, advertisements, explanations, newspaper/news reports and descriptions.

**Guided Reading-** Children will be focussing on their inference skills and retrieving data to answer questions.

### French

**Music** - Children will be continuing to sing in assemblies for the first half term. In the second half term we will be making our own Anglo Saxon songs and creating music to perform alongside.

We will be experimenting with a range of instruments for effect, confidence and control.

### Religious Education

The children will be finishing their work on the psalms, looking in-depth at Jesus and stories such as the boy in the temple and Jesus' baptism. We will also look at the Jewish Sabbath and within the second half term we will focus on payers and 'what matters most'.

### Enterprise

### P.E

Children will take part in weekly swimming lessons at the outdoor pool in Haltwhistle.

During school based lessons we will be improving our athletics skills in preparation for sports day and our team game this term will be cricket.

## KS2 Summer Term 2016

### Design and Technology - Art and design

The children are working in groups to design and make their own Anglo Saxon village.

We will be making brooches, our own artefacts and puzzles using a range of materials and techniques. Each of these will be researched, designed, made then evaluated.

### Science

In Science we are focussing on Living things and their environment. Looking at our own local environment and working out how we can help.

We will be coving; working scientifically, living things and their habitats and animals including humans.

**History** - We will be looking in depth at Anglo-Saxon culture, villages and history. Children will learn about artefacts, professions, battles and much more.

Within the first week of half term the children asked some questions about the Anglo-Saxons. We will have some children initiated learning and adult lead lessons answering these.

**ICT** - Children will be using ICT in many lessons during this project for research, presentations and database work.

We will focus on branching databases, using publisher to create a leaflet, poster, google earth and using the internet safely and responsibly.
