#### Learning Achievements

**Reception/Class 1**: this week we have been busy making Brazilian sweets and writing instructions on how to make them. We have also been learning about describing position, movement and turns in Maths and making masks linked to 'Giraffes Can't Dance' and creating our own carnival dance.

**Class 2:** this week the children have been learning all about natural selection and how animals have adapted over the years. They successfully debated Darwin's theory of evolution. In Maths the children have been recording their own data in bar charts and line graphs. Mary Anning, the famous fossil collector, kept the children occupied as they researched her life. Observational drawings in their Darwin journals took place on the Millennium Green with the children producing detailed sketches of flowers and leaves.
