#### **Learning Achievements**

**Reception:** enjoyed their trip to Waitrose where we looked at different jobs within the shop. In Maths, we have been looking at estimating.

**Class 1:** have been writing instructions on how to care for a minibeast and have been learning about different micro habitats. In Maths, they have continued to work on place value and creating pictograms.

Class 2: have been researching and reading top tips to plant a tree in preparation for their debut Gardener's World Radio station on Greenhead FM! They have planted a Japanese maple in the school grounds following their own instructions on the dos and don'ts of tree planting. In Maths, the children have been adding and subtracting money and decimals. The germination rate of cress and lettuce seeds has been the focus for our Science investigation this week with the children placing the seeds in different locations around school.

#### **Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar**

We are very excited to announce that we will be using resources from SPaG.com to assist the children in years 1-6 in their learning. SPaG focuses on improving spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Your child (ren) will receive their own individual password and username which will be stuck into the front cover of their white home/school book and you will be notified by the class teacher when your child has an assessment to complete online. The assessments aim to consolidate the learning that has taken place in the classroom so your child should understand what is being asked of them in the set questions. SPaG.com offers new and updated tests for both KS1 and KS2 - based on the latest government samples.

To help familiarise children, each online SPaG.com test includes the full range of question stems: match, explain, rewrite, identify, write and complete. Each test also covers all areas of grammar, vocabulary and punctuation. Alongside each question, a helpful tracking tool allows the children to track their progress through the test.

Each test report also provides a detailed breakdown of which children got each particular question correct or not. This helps inform a teacher's planning and also helps identify individual targets for children.

If you have any difficulties accessing your child's account or do not have access to a computer or the internet please let your child's class teacher know.

### Hedgehog Talk - Friday 11th May

Chris Kieler will be coming into school to talk to the children about hedgehogs, their habitat and their diet. Chris works closely with the Hedgehog Preservation Society and rescues hedgehogs until they are back to full health and can be released back into the wild.
